

How to Use Your Vehicle Disinfection Mats

Set up

- Use appropriate protective clothing for the disinfectant you are using
- Place the black absorbent pad inside the blue waterproof sleeve
- Place the 4 mats where they are going to be used on a level surface as shown in the diagram below:



Blue sleeves can be trimmed by up to 10cm to give additional width if necessary

- Pre-mix the disinfectant to the recommended strength in a bucket or similar container. You will need 45 to 60 litres per 180 x 90 cm mat (180 to 240 litres in total)
- Pour the disinfectant slowly over the black absorbent pad giving it time to soak in
- Fill the pad until it is saturated and liquid appears when you lightly put your foot on the pad, leave it for 5 minutes and top it up.
- Do not overfill the mats.

Using the mat

- Make sure vehicles pass over the mat at no more than 5 mph. We suggest funnelling vehicles through a narrow entrance to the mats and displaying the sign provided.
- Do not overfill the mats or they may burst when driven over by heavy lorries.

Maintenance

- Top up the mat by slowly pouring in extra pre-mixed disinfectant if the mat becomes dry. You should always be able to see liquid when you put your foot lightly on the pad.
- Replenish within the effective active time of the disinfectant you are using (which should be shown on the packaging).
- For best results, clean the mats weekly by removing the pad from the sleeve, hosing them thoroughly and letting them dry.
- Clean the mats if they get very dirty with mud or other organic matter. Most disinfectants will be less effective if left in a dirty mat.



After use

- Dispose of contents safely
- Remove black pad from sleeve, hose thoroughly and allow to dry
- Store in a dry area when not in use.
